Thanks to Alice, Beverly, Shirley (and me) who made trees to send.

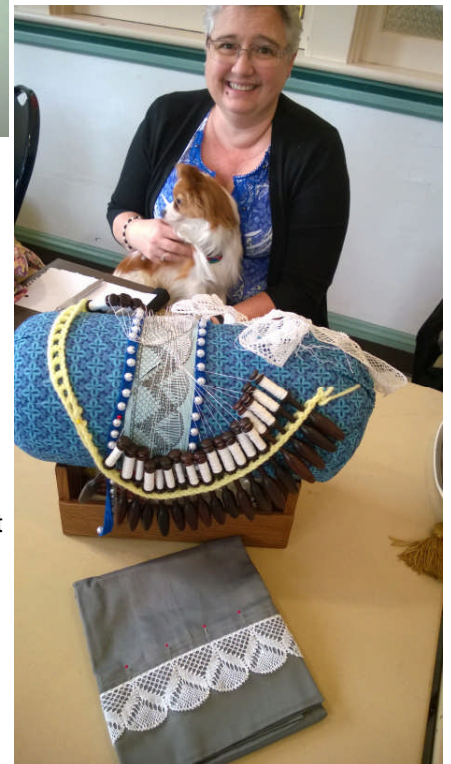
Pauline has been practicing on her bolster pillow. She of course has had some help from a very interested friend — (lucky dog). Someone is going to get some very nice pillow cases too.

This is a Kortelahti pattern from the book "Bobbin Lace", worked in Moravia 40 linen thread. Size is 8 x 24 inches, not counting the fringe.

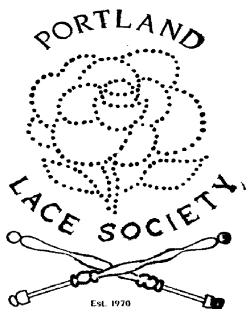
It is one of the patterns that's been on my list for years. I dumped a project from a wide roller pillow, and decided it would be a good time to try it.

Actually, I started it twice. I wound all the bobbins and did about an inch. I had six thread breaks, including two on the same pin, so I dumped that thread and started over. I was very tired of winding bobbins that week.

I'm still looking for the right hanger for it. I put holes across the top so I could put a stick through them. The pattern was not designed for hanging free. I also added the fringe.
